BFH provides housing, trauma services, counseling, education and hope to children who are 12-17 years old that are survivors of sex trafficking.

Did you know:

- 57% of those trafficked are children
- A child is reported missing every 2 seconds
- 7 years is the average lifespan of someone trafficked

The Blanket Fort Hope Restoration Home recently had its grand opening and will begin operation in early 2026.


