December 8 | 9:30 & 11:00 AM

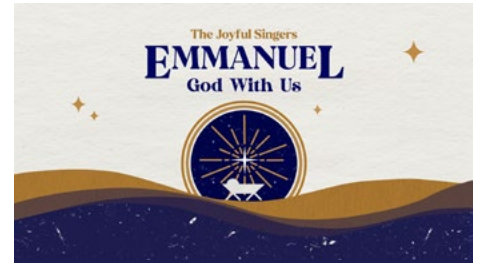
