Since 1845, the IMB (International Mission Board) has partnered with churches to send missionaries to live and work among the 4.5 billion people around the world with little to no access to the gospel. This is made possible through support from the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering (LMCO). The LMCO supports 3623 missionaries who live among these unreached peoples and serve through humanitarian aid, evangelism, discipleship and church planting. In 2019, there were 89,325 new believers worldwide.

The LMCO collection goal for the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) is \$175 million dollars. This financial gift collected by thousands of SBC churches will allow the International Mission Board (IMB) to focus on ministry access, outreach and evangelism, humanitarian relief, missionary care, and discipleship and training projects all over the world.

A Small Group gift of \$180 will make it possible for one child to attend the Alabama Baptist Children's Homes Camp of Champions for foster children and foster families. This camp is supplied free of cost for Alabama Baptist foster families and foster children. This is the only camp experience that many foster children ever get to attend. Children get to experience typical camp activities along with Biblical instruction.

Missionaries G and L

Office equipment is needed for tutoring children with special needs, literacy, computer classes, and small business classes. Here are some examples of equipment needed.

- 8. Desktop computer (need 5) -- \$900 each**
- 9. Printer (need 2) -- \$120 each**
- 10. Photocopier (1) -- \$370**
- 11. White Boards (need 2) -- \$20 each**
- 12. Desks/ Tables/ Chairs – approximately \$500 for all**

Medical Help will be used for people who are in desperate medical situations. Often, they have been faced with a medical situation for years and have no financial means to look for even simple medical help. Others have infants that need immediate medical care, but their financial situation forces them to wait. Each situation is different, but the need is always there.

13. A typical life-saving surgery or treatment is usually around \$80 per person.

The ministry currently serves South Shades Crest Elementary, Brocks Gap Intermediate, and Trace Crossings Elementary. Deliver your food bags to the church office from November 29-December 15.
