LOTTIE MOON GOAL: \$250,000

As of 2025, it is estimated that about 42% to 43.5% of the world's population—approximately 3.4 to 3.6 billion people—are considered unreached with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

This population includes people groups with little to no access to the Bible, churches, or Christian resources, and where less than 2% of the population identifies as evangelical Christian.

There are more than 7,200 distinct unreached people groups globally, which represents over 40% of all ethnic people groups worldwide.

Through authentic equestrian and agricultural experiences, they help individuals find hope and restoration.

SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE

The Birmingham South chapter of the national nonprofit Sleep in Heavenly Peace is composed of volunteers that build twin and bunk beds for local children ages 3-17 who don't have a bed of their own. Did you know that it is estimated that 3% of the children in our communities are sleeping on pallets, couch cushions, 4-5 to a bed, or with a parent? In addition to the bed, they also receive a brand-new twin mattress, new waterproof mattress protector, sheet set, comforter, and pillow.

Volunteers join with other volunteers from schools, churches, businesses, and civic organizations to build beds. They serve local kids in the Bessemer, Hueytown, Pleasant Grove, McCalla, Fairfield, Midfield, Helena, Forestdale, and Hoover zip code areas.

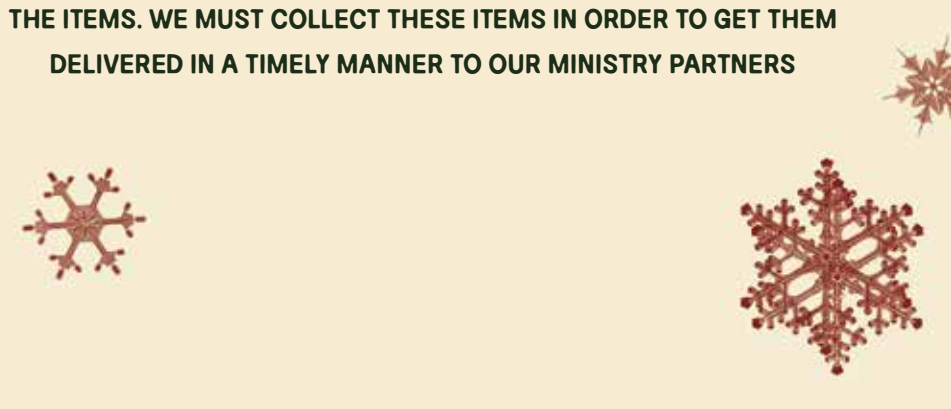

BIRMINGHAM METRO BAPTIST ASSOCIATION & SERVING YOU @ THE GRACE PLACE

Partner with the BMBA and The Grace Place to provide Christmas stockings to children in our area who are in need. Stockings will be given to local children through other churches and ministries in the Birmingham Metro Area with a goal of pointing these children and their parents to Jesus. **Our goal this year is 200 Stockings.**

Stockings with instructions about what to include will be available in the Chapel area and across from the Home Front beginning **November 9**. All the stockings have been sewn by our Sewing Ministry, The Heavenly Crafters. You can fill them with snacks, candy, coloring books, crayons, or small toys (no nuts or fruit, please). A label will be attached to the back of the stocking specifying whether it is for a boy or girl and the age group (newborn to 2, ages 3-5, grades 1-3, grades 4-6, middle school, or high school).

Stockings will ONLY be collected on Sunday, November 30.
