## MORE THAN A MEDICAL CLINIC ministering to mental health

Through the new Hunter Street Medical Clinic, we will share the love of Jesus Christ with our neighbors by providing basic mental health care to uninsured individuals of Hoover and surrounding communities. The need for this type of clinic was discovered by observing the lack of access in this part of town, especially to our Spanish-speaking neighbors.

Having this available resource aids in providing quality care for mental health wellness in areas such as depression and anxiety for individuals 18 years of age and older through a physician, two certified registered nurse practitioners, and other volunteers.

"We know that mental health issues are on the rise, and medicine can only be part of the solution. Our prayer is that as we share Jesus with our patients and provide care, we will see smiles return and anxiety decrease," says Kristen Johnston, one of the nurse practitioners who helped set up the ministry.

Although the clinic is not equipped to treat attention deficit disorder or more severe illnesses such as schizophrenia or bipolar disorder, referrals to other providers will be made as necessary. Due to the limited clinic hours, we are not able to offer emergency services and thus would defer to local Emergency Departments and 911 Emergency services

Along with care and support, the clinic also opens doors for Gospel conversations and spiritual encouragement.

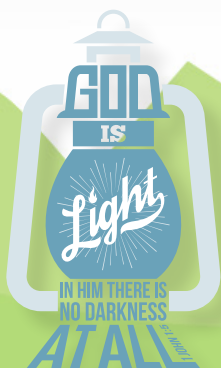
**WHERE:** Hunter Street Baptist Church in the Recreation Center near the back of campus. Parking is available near the entrance to the clinic and is handicap accessible.
