## Hunter Street Missions



COVID-19 presented many challenges across ministries worldwide. It has been a particularly challenging time for Missions Pastors, like our own Lee Dymond, whose job is to train and send people on mission. "My hope has always been to mobilize as many Hunter Street members as possible to go on missions. Unfortunately, that was just not something we could do for over a year due to the COVID-19 pandemic," Lee says.

While COVID-19 halted teams, Lee believes that God allowed the time to be productive in the vision of how Hunter Street could build on the Missions foundation that the church has laid for the last twenty years. "That in itself was a great blessing," he points out. "The time allowed us to develop a comprehensive Mission Strategy for Hunter Street Baptist Church. We have also been able to connect with some new Covenant Mission Partners that we are very

excited to serve alongside."

This fall, there are 15 mission trips scheduled. Teams are going to Clarkston, Baltimore, New York City, Gambia, London, and Las Vegas. "It is pretty exciting to return. We have not sent a Mission Team to the field since March 2020," Lee says. "I know that Hunter Street members are ready to go! In fact, since last August, I have been asked almost every week when we were going to start sending teams out again. Our Covenant Mission Partners are also ready for us to come back and serve with them."
