


# Welcome Jared Wilson this Sunday!

Jared Wilson is Assistant Professor of Pastoral Ministry and Author in Residence at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Director of the Pastoral Training Center at Liberty Baptist Church, both in Kansas City, Missouri. He is the author of numerous books, including *The Imperfect Disciple, The Gospel According to Satan,* and his newest, *Love Me Anyway: How God's Perfect Love Fills Our Deepest Longing.* Jared also serves as General Editor at *For The Church* (ftc.co) and co-host of the For *The Church Podcast* and *Christianity Today's Art of Pastoring* Podcast.
